### B) Pension Plan Administrators Goals

Steve Shanks reviewed his goals for 2025 with the Board. He noted that he continues to train Becky Schiller to use QuickBooks and that she has been taking on increased accounting responsibilities and has been reviewing financial statements and the Citywide bank account in a timely manner.

Steve Shanks will continue to explore IT services. The current provider, which has few governmental clients, does not have their internal controls audited and has not provided written documentation of their internal controls. Steve hopes to find an IT services provider that will be more of a partner to help GERP achieve some additional goals. Some of the technological goals include allowing participants to sign documents online, securely, with some assurance of the identity of the signor.

In addition, given that estimates are mostly automated, allowing a participant to get information about their benefit online is a long-term goal. The security of the data is of utmost importance and is the reason that Staff has been cautious about this process.

Steve continues to work on the Electronic Document Repository and would like the Board to have access to a greater number of historical documents and reports.

Steve Shanks and staff will conduct a participant survey by the end of June.
